## Sunday mornings: Mark

Making sense of our world and our lives can be baffling at times. What is going on, how do the different pieces fit together?

Mark's gospel forces us to look at Jesus. He tells His story. This is a book made up of episodes; of simple, beautiful, at times disturbing things that Christ did. Scene after scene, it moves at pace, and tells a story which strangely and powerfully not only teaches us about Jesus but introduces him to us, and us to him. In fact you will discover, through the pages of this gospel, that he knows you and loves you. Mark says, 'I've got someone who I want you to meet, and if you let him, he'll put the pieces of your life into place.'
